

## ⇒ The Late Daya Narotam Bhoola Family ⇐



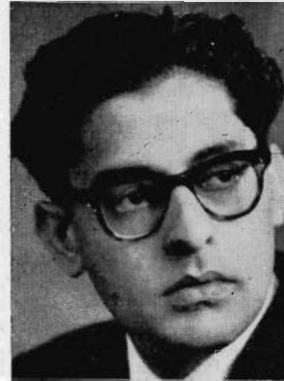
**BHOOLA, Narotam** (late); b. Rander, Surat. One of the pioneer Indian merchants. Settled in Sutherland, near Pietermaritzburg. Founded the well known business of N. Bhoola in 1901, which subsequently included sons as partners. Was always interested in the welfare of his community and helped in this connection. Is survived by a widow and 1 daughter and 5 sons—

Maka, Thakor, Laloo, Ishwar and Thribovan.

**BHOOLA, Daya Narotam** (late); b. Rander, India, 1900; educ. Sutherland and St. Aidan's College, Sydenham. On leaving school joined father's business at Plessislaer. In 1955 joined the well known firm of N. Bhoola & Sons (Pty.), Ltd., Durban, with which he was connected till his death. Was connected with all the public activities. Survived by widow, 4 d., 3 s.—Keshavlal, Kanti, and Navin.



**BHOOLA, Doctor Kanti Daya, M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., B.Sc. (Pathology)**; 2nd s. of the late Daya N. Bhoola; b. Plessislaer (Sutherland), 11th Oct., 1930; matriculated at Sastri College with First Class Honours; completed first year medical B.A. at Witwatersrand University, Johannesburg, proceeded to Ireland and joined University College, Dublin. Had a brilliant university career, obtaining honours in first, second, and third year studies; received the Doctor Henry Hutchison Stuart Scholarship in Anatomy and Physiology; obtained first prize in anatomy dissections, which are on display in College Medical Museum, Dublin; passed final medical examination with honours in medicine and surgery in 1956; graduated in B.Sc. Pathology in 1957 with first class honours. Joined City General Hospital, Stoke-on-Trent, England.



**BHOOLA, Doctor Keshavial Daya, B.Sc. (Hygiene), M.B., B.Ch., B.A.O., L.A.H., M.P.S.I.**; e. s. of the late Daya N. Bhoola; b. Plessislaer (Sutherland), 24th April, 1928; educ. at Sastri College, proceeded to Fort Hare in 1947, where he obtained degree in B.Sc. (Hygiene). In 1950 proceeded to University College, Dublin (Ireland) for medical studies, graduated in 1955, having obtained honours in the following subjects: Anatomy, Physiology, Pathology, Ophthalmology and Midwifery. In the same year also wrote examination at the Apothecaries Hall, Dublin and obtained the L.A.H. degree. Has been appointed mem. of the Pharmaceutical Society of Ireland. Returned to South Africa in 1956 and joined McCords Zulu Hospital, Durban. In 1957 made an extensive tour of India returning in 1958. Has started Medical Practice in Durban at 72 Acorn Rd. 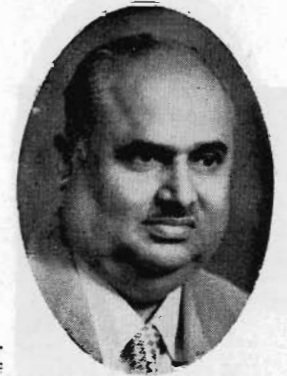
**BHOOLA, Narotam** (late); b. Rander, Surat. One of the pioneer Ind.
